# **COVID-19 ARRANGEMENTS**

In line with DfE recommendations we are remaining open to vulnerable children and the children of critical workers (when both parents are critical workers) only. All other pupils should not attend and should learn remotely until February half-term. Pupils who are self-isolating should not attend school. Clinically extremely vulnerable pupils are also advised not to attend school.

Remote learning is being provided by your child's teacher on a daily basis. If you are experiencing any problems accessing the work, please do not hesitate to contact us. We will not be providing live online lessons but teachers will be producing recorded lessons on SeeSaw and Loom. We understand that home schooling your child/ren is not easy but urge you not to become stressed by any of the work we are sending home. Teachers are available throughout the school day on their class email and SeeSaw and the School Office is manned every day from 8.30am -4.00pm.

The infection rate in our local area is much higher now than it was in April and yet we have 5 times more children in school now than then. We urge you to heed the advice of Public Health to 'STAY AT HOME'.
